President, Elected Annually, 4 term limit (depending on legislation may be elected by membership or may be elected by board)

Duties:

- Preside at all meetings of the Board
 - Appoint necessary committees and chairpersons
 - Assign president and directors to specific duties
 - Serve as the chief executive officer of the association
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Vice President, Elected Annually, 4 term limit (depending on legislation may be elected by membership or may be elected by board)

Duties:

- In absence of the president, assume responsibilities of the president
 - Be responsible for providing the best possible service to our members
 - As chairperson of specific association committees, conduct committee meetings as necessary for successful completion of assigned tasks.
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Directors, 2 year term (number and term limites to be determined by pending legislation)

Duties:

Assist the board in completing assigned tasks such as:

- Conducting the Association championships and other tournaments
 - Distribution of awards.
 - Be thoroughly familiar the USBC's rules of play to assist our members with answers to league or rules questions.
 - Be an ambassador for the sport of bowling.
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Youth Directors, 2 year term (term limit to be determined by pending legislation)

Duties of Youth Directors are basically the same as regular directors in addition to being a youth advocate on the board.
