CHAMPAIGN AREA USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP 2018-19 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament will be certified and conducted under the rules of the USBC Youth.
2. Anyone may bowl in this tournament provided that he/she has paid the Champaign Area USBC Youth dues.
3. Divisions for this tournament are: U12 and U20. For Singles and All-Events, bowler's age determines his or her division. For team and doubles events, the age of the oldest bowler determines the division.
4. Teams must be composed of four (4) members.
5. Mixed entries (boys and girls) will be accepted.
6. Bowlers may bowl in team event as many times as they want. No more than 3 players can compete together more than once on the same team. Bowlers may participate in singles, doubles or both. Bowlers may bowl doubles more than once but not with the same partner. Singles may bowl only once. Bowlers participating in all three events (team, doubles and singles) are automatically entered in all-events.
7. Walk-in entries will be accepted provided there is room on the squad.
8. Handicap will be figured on bowler's highest USBC average as of January 1, 2019, based on six (6) or more games in league play. Bowlers with six (6) games of league play as of the date of participation may bowl if verified by the league coach in writing. If a bowler does not have six (6) games, their 2017-18 book average will be used. If no 2017-18 book average, then bowler must bowl scratch.
9. Entry fee is to be paid with entry form.
10. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 210. No absentee scores are permitted. In the team and doubles events, handicap will be the total of the handicap of the individual players.
11. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of total pins plus handicap.
12. Trophies will be awarded for the first place in each event for each division. Additional trophies will be awarded in each division based on 1 out of every 10 entries. First series bowled in each event will count for all-events.
13. After a game has started, a substitute will be allowed only in case of the disability of a player; combined scores shall count. The bowler bowling the most frames would be eligible for awards or advancement. If they each bowl the same number of frames, the bowler paying the entry would qualify.
14. Bowling shall begin in accordance with previously arranged schedule. Bowlers who arrive late will begin play with the score counting beginning with the frame being bowled.
15. All bowlers should check in one-half (1/2) hour before scheduled bowling time. Coach must verify and sign all entry forms for the accuracy of the average.
16. In case of a tie for first place in any division, co-champions will be observed. Each will get the designated award and payment option to advance to the State Tournament.
17. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours. All action of the Tournament Committee shall be final. The CAUSBC Youth Committee will constitute the Tournament Committee.
18. There will be no eating or drinking in the bowler area during this tournament. No smoking or use of tobacco products by bowlers during competition.
19. No one is permitted in bowler's area except the participants, the official scorers, and tournament officials.
20. The total fee will be \$15.00 per bowler for each event.
21. The entire trophy fee collected will be returned 100% in the form of trophies.
22. The lineup will remain the same as on the entry form. Subs shall replace person he or she is bowling for in the lineup and once a substitution has been made it cannot be changed.
23. No parents or coaches will be allowed to keep score for their own youth bowlers, except when deemed necessary by the tournament manager.
24. Winners in each division of the Team, Doubles and Singles Events will represent the Champaign Area USBC Youth in the Illinois State USBC Youth Championship Tournament to be held at Spare Time Lanes, Decatur, IL in March/April 2019. Additional teams, doubles and singles may participate in the State Tournament at their own expense.
