

# GENERAL RULES

1. Bowlers will bowl in the positions assigned by the tournament committee. Doubles entries submitted at the time of original entry will be scheduled to bowl together if possible. Lane assignments will be assigned by the tournament committee.
2. Replacements must bowl in the same place as the original bowler. A replacement in fact will become the original bowler and all prize money will be paid to the bowler actually bowling the event.
3. All squads will start on time unless held up due to equipment failure. A tardy bowler's score shall start in the frame in which he enters the game. Ten minutes of practice will be given, starting ten minutes **before** the **scheduled** starting time of a squad, lane availability permitting.
4. Averages of bowlers potentially cashing **must** be verified by their league secretary. While the Tournament Committee will strive to collect league standing sheets from each CA USBC league for this verification process (and have available for persons in the entry process), verification forms may be given to bowlers scoring over an established threshold if the tournament committee does not have the standings sheet in hand for a league which the bowler is known to bowl. These verification forms must be returned to the tournament committee by the deadline indicated on the form or the bowler risks disqualification. In the event that a bowlers reported current average is incorrect, the average and handicap will be adjusted. Bowlers will have 48 hours within bowling to assure that we have their correct average.
5. Tournament management reserves the right to make full squads or limit the size of squads based on lane availability..
6. **All prepaid entries must be accompanied by full fees. Entries will not be scheduled until fees are paid. There will be a \$25.00 charge for any returned check for any reason. All entries paid for by such checks will be cancelled or disqualified (if check returned after bowling). Failure to pay for returned check will be cause for USBC disciplinary action.**
7. Automatic scorers will be official and the bowler and at least one other competitor must initial the correctness of the transference of the score to the *OFFICIAL RECAP SHEET*. In the event of a loss of scores from the automatic scorers, games lost may need to be rebowled in their entirety in accordance with USBC rules.
9. Unmarried grade or high school students who have not attained the age of 18 must have written consent of their parent or guardian in order to bowl in this tournament. This consent must be on a form approved by the USBC and on file with the tournament secretary at least one week before the bowler bowls, unless he is accompanied by his parent or guardian in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the youth starts to bowl.
10. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entrant prior to the scheduled time of bowling or at any time later in the tournament should an entrant be discovered ineligible to compete in accordance with the participation rules listed under TOURNAMENT RULES AND GENERAL RULES. Any entrant so rejected after beginning to bowl shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money. The committee shall remove from the lanes, after one warning, any entrant, who in the judgement of the committee, is guilty of misconduct.
11. In the case of a breakdown, the tournament committee reserves the right to move the bowlers to an alternate pair of lanes. If moved, each bowler will be allowed ONE practice ball on each of the alternate lanes with no reracks between shots.
12. The tournament management will be the Tournaments Committee of the Champaign Area USBC Association. Any protests must be submitted to the committee prior to the payment of prizes.
13. USBC rules shall govern any situation not covered by the above rules.

# TOURNAMENT RULES

**CERTIFICATION:** This tournament will be certified by the USBC.

**PARTICIPATION:** All members of the USBC and CA USBC as of Jan 18, 2019 are eligible to enter. All bowlers in this tournament must not have a 2017-18 CA USBC Yearbook average of over 199 (highest average); or bowlers with no 2017-18 CA USBC Yearbook average must not have a current USBC average in a CA USBC certified league of over 199 in their highest league with 21 or more games as of Jan 19, 2019. Bowlers not qualifying by the preceding conditions will not be eligible for this tournament.

## EVENTS:

**SINGLES:** All bowlers will bowl a singles event each time they bowl. Bowlers may enter this event up to four times but cash in the singles only once. Bowlers will bowl four games on one pair of lanes and use the highest three games plus handicap for the singles event.

**DOUBLES:** Bowlers will be allowed to pair up with other bowlers on their squad for a "doubles" event. The event will consist of the first three games bowled by each partner including handicap. The Singles and Doubles events will be bowled simultaneously. Both bowlers must enter the doubles event. Bowlers may pair with as many other bowlers as they want **on their squad**. Doubles entries for bowlers on a squad will be accepted up to the scheduled starting time of the squad.

**HANDICAP:** 100% of 220 scratch.

**AVERAGES:** For tournament handicap purposes, bowlers will use **highest** average in any CA USBC league as of Jan 19, 2019 with 21 or more games or highest 2017-18 CA USBC yearbook average, whichever is higher. If no average of 21 or more games as of Jan 18, 2019 bowler will use 2017-18 highest CA USBC Yearbook average. Entrants with current averages over 220 will bowl scratch. USBC Rules 319d and 319e will be waived for this tournament.

**ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees must be paid prior to bowling. If a check is returned unpaid for ANY reason, the entry for which it paid for will be cancelled until guaranteed funds are provided to the Tournament Committee along with a \$25 charge. In the SINGLES event the entry fee is \$30.00 per individual (\$15.00 bowling and expense fee, \$15.00 prize fee). In the DOUBLES event the entry fee for each doubles pair is \$20.00 (\$20.00 prize fee). **ALL PRIZE FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100% IN THE FORM OF CASH PRIZES.**

**RESERVATIONS AND ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Reservations will only be held with paid entries. Walk ins will be accepted up to **one half hour** before the **scheduled** starting time of any squad, space permitting. The tournament management reserves the right to shift bowlers to different squads to minimize small squads. Bowlers will be given sufficient notice in the event of a squad change.

**AWARDS:** All *cash* awards will be paid on a handicap basis. Bowlers may cash only once in the singles event and only once **with the same partner** in the doubles event. At least **one in six** entrants will cash in both the singles and doubles events. In the case of a tie for any event championship the tied participants will split the prize monies (i.e. a two way tie for first place will split the combination of first and second place prize money) Ties for any other places will split the prize monies for the adjacent places. Doubles monetary awards will be paid to both bowlers, regardless of who paid the entry fee.
