TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is United States Bowling Congress(USBC) sanctioned. Any current youth member of the USBC and Champaign Area USBC who has bowled at least 9 games in a sanctioned youth league at a center within the boundaries of the Champaign Area USBC is eligible to bowl.
2. This is a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220. The bowler's average, for handicapping purposes, will be the bowler's current average as of January 1, 2019 (9 games minimum). Any bowler not having a minimum of 9 games as of January 1, 2019 or at the time of bowling, shall use their 2017-2018 yearbook average; all others shall bowl scratch.
3. All entry fees must be paid prior to bowling. Walk-in entries close 30 minutes prior to the qualifying squad time, providing there is space available. All walk-in entries will be subject to a \$5 late fee.
4. Lane assignments will be assigned by the tournament officials based on size of squad.
5. All prizes shall be in the form of scholarships and administered by the USBC SMART Program, 621 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, Texas, 76011, Account #9089. Prize fee(s) will be returned 100% and at a ratio of one in ten entries.
6. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entrant prior to the scheduled time of bowling or at any time later in the tournament should an entrant be discovered ineligible to compete. Any entrant so rejected after beginning to bowl shall forfeit all entry fees and prize money. The committee shall remove from the lanes, after one warning, any entrant, who in the judgment of the committee is guilty of misconduct.
7. In case of a breakdown, the tournament committee reserves the right to move the bowlers to an alternate pair of lanes. If moved, each bowler will be allowed ONE practice ball (no re-racks) on each of the alternate lanes.
8. Tournament management will be the Youth Committee of the Champaign Area USBC Association.
9. USBC rules shall govern any situation not covered by the above.
10. The tournament format will be as listed below. All squads will start on time unless held up by delays beyond the control of the Tournament Committee. Any bowler arriving late for any squad will receive 0 for any frames missed. In the case of a tie for the last qualifying spot, a one game roll-off will be held between the tied parties prior to the beginning of the finals.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

All bowling will be at Arrowhead Lanes in Champaign, Illinois. Qualifying will be on February 17, 2019 at Noon. Qualifying will consist of bowling three (3) games on the pair the bowler was assigned. The six (6) highest scoring bowlers will advance to the finals. If a tie for the sixth spot should occur, a one-game roll-off will be bowled to break the tie (handicap included). The Finals will begin immediately after the completion of qualifying.

Finals will consist of the six bowlers bowling one game on the same pair of lanes. The bowler with the lowest score (with handicap) will be eliminated. Additional games will be bowled with one bowler being eliminated each game. If a tie should occur for the "elimination" spot, a 9th and 10th frame roll off (with handicap) will be used to determine who advances. Games will be bowled until there is One Remaining "Survivor" who will then be declared the champion. The Finals will begin on February 17, 2019 immediately after qualifying has ended.
