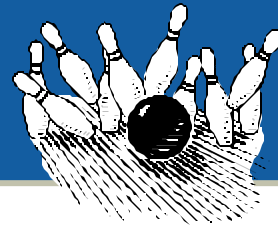

A membership meeting of the Champaign Area USBC Association has been scheduled for 6:00pm on Tuesday, October 9, 2007 at Western Bowl. The purpose of the meeting is to hold elections for the delegates who will represent the CAUSBCA at the state associations: Illinois USBC BA and Illinois USBC WBA meetings. Nominations for these candidates will be taken from the floor prior to voting.

Delegates for the National USBC Convention in Kansas City, MO in May 2008 will also be selected at this membership meeting. Delegates for the Illinois USBC Youth Association will be selected at a future youth committee meeting.

This will be the only meeting during the season to select delegates for the state and national meetings. Everyone is encouraged to attend.

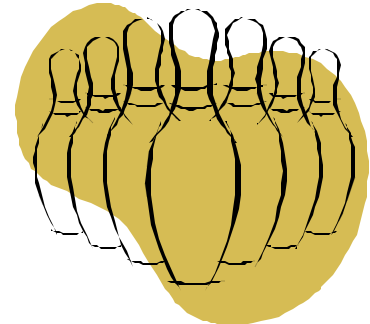
Entry blanks should be available in the centers by the first of October and on www.c-ubowl.com.

Pepsi USBC Youth Championships



This year's Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Finals will take place in Detroit, Michigan next July. The road to Detroit starts in league continues through the Zone tournament and then to the State level in the spring.

This year's league qualifier will be during the period of October 13 through 26. There is no additional charge at the league level. All youth bowlers have to do is bowl during their regularly scheduled league session. This tournament is based on pins over average and has both scratch and handicap divisions.

Mike put a couple of worn out finger lifts in the fingers and enough tape in the thumbhole to fit. The resulting triplicate earns Mike a USBC award.

Did you know?

USBC is offering a contest to develop a device for measuring the amount of friction on a bowling lane to determine compliance with USBC guidelines for certified competition? They will award a \$5,000 first-place prize to the individual or team submitting the best design. Second prize is \$2,000.

Although directed toward college students as a topic for research assignments, anyone over age 18 is eligible to participate in the contest.
